

PCARS EMERGENCY NET ROLL CALL (MELBOURNE REGION)

Net Control Operators should deliver the preamble in a calm unhurried well-enunciated voice to provide an example of the way that messages and communications should be delivered in an actual emergency. The example set by the net control operator is of great importance is avoiding any suggestion of urgency or panic.

I will now take check-ins with suffixes November thru Sierra. **(pause)**

I will now take check-ins with suffixes Tango thru Zulu. **(pause)**

Are there any other check-ins throughout the Alphabet. **(pause)**

I will now take traffic from the following stations.

(Call them one at a time and record their traffic and acknowledge.)

(Any Melbourne news or information of interest provided by the EC can be sent at this time.)

Are there any late check-ins for the net? **(pause)**
