

TX5C Clipperton Island DXpedition – 2008 By Bill Beyer, N2WB and Al Hernandez, K3VN

Clipperton Island is a nine-square-kilometer coral atoll in the North Pacific Ocean, southwest of Mexico and west of Costa Rica, at 10°18'N, 109°13'W. It is a five day trip by boat from California.

Clipperton is an overseas possession of France administered by the Minister of Overseas France and has no permanent inhabitants.

AI-K3VN and Bill-N2WB were members of the TX5C team. The team made a total of 71, 794 QSO's in 156 hours of operation under severe weather conditions including high heat and humidity.
