FCC Amateur Radio Testing Information

FCC Amateur Radio Exams will be given at the Hamfest. Persons who are coming to take an exam and not attend the Hamfest will not be required to purchase a Hamfest ticket. Those not purchasing a ticket will not be allowed to remain in the Auditorium. Tickets may be purchased after testing.

Testing: Saturday morning 10 AM. Location: behind the stage in the Auditorium at the south end of the building.

Pre-Registration is required: send an email to gary@w4gal.com and instructions will be provided. **Walk-ins wishing to take an exam will NOT be allowed to test.**

Check-in time is 9:50 AM. We will check **ONCE** outside the east door of the Auditorium at 9:50 AM for those who wish to test but not attend the Hamfest. All of those candidates will be brought in to the exam as a group and will be ushered out as a group after the testing.

These exams are coordinated by the W4GAL-Team of the Laurel-VEC program. There is no charge to take Laurel-VEC exams. Use your money to buy a Hamfest ticket (but it's not required)!

You must bring the following:

1. A copy of your FCC license if you are licensed
2. A copy of your CSCE if one has been issued to you in the last 365 days
3. One form of photo ID (driver's license or passport) if 16 or older
4. A mask may be required. We don't know yet. Bring one.

When you pre-register, you will need an FRN issued by the FCC. We do not use social security numbers. We will have your FCC Form 605 ready to be signed when you arrive.
